No entering the running area for safety. If your child falls over please leave this for staff to manage. We will call on you if needed.
11.45	Races end Pupils return to class	
11.45-12.15	Gates open	Parents may leave or join for lunchtime during this short time slot. Parents may use an area of the field to set up a picnic.
12.15	GATES CLOSE	Parents entering or leaving will need to go through the school accompanied by staff.
12.00-12.15	KS1 will collect packed lunch and return to their year group zone on the field.	Parents may collect a child from their zone.
12.00-12.15	KS2 will collect packed lunch and return to their year group zone on the field	Parents may collect a child from their zone
1.00	Whistle goes – all pupils line up on the field in their original zones	Children to return to class. If you need to take children home early, you will need to sign them out with their class teacher at 1.00. Gates will be closed until this time.
1.00-1.15	Gates open for parents to leave	Please do not leave the site with children unless they have been signed out to avoid phone calls and possible reports of missing children.
