School Uniform

We are proud to see the vast majority of children wearing school uniform. The children feel it is so important that they want to lead a worship on it themselves. A very small number of children are not in uniform. We usually give these children uniform for the day and let parents know.

When children all wear the same, it helps them to feel calm and settled. When some children wear different clothes, it causes anxiety. Children worry that the rules are not going to keep them safe, they worry that they feel pressured to also not wear uniform and parents become frustrated because it is difficult for them to reinforce the rules because they are told that other children don't wear uniform.

Recently some girls have been coming in skirts that are too short to be practical and ride up their legs when sitting, stop them from climbing and running and lead them to constantly adjusting and pulling on them.

We value your support in making sure children are in uniform and so don't have to worry about what they are wearing.
